

FINANCE COUNCIL'S CORNER APRIL, 2024

In order to be keep you updated on our Parish's financial situation, Finance Council has decided to provide a

year-to-date Financial Update in the bulletin on the 3rd Sunday of each month.

As we updated parishioners at all of the Masses the weekend of

January 20 & 21, 2024, the Parish ended the 2023 fiscal year

(January to December, 2023) in a balanced position! Thank you for your

contributions in 2023!

While we were able to balance our books in 2023, so far 2024, our receipts (that is, our weekly and monthly collections) are not covering our costs. In fact, the following Financial Update shows that, for the first quarter of the fiscal year, collections are covering only 90.9% of our operating costs, leaving us with a sizeable OPERATING DEFICIT (\$23,496):

As you have likely noticed, our Mass attendance has been increasing substantially lately. Bless God! Every week, more and more souls are making their way to St. Patrick's to attend the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, where they are nourished by the Word of God and by the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, really and truly present in the most Holy Sacrament of the Altar!

Praise be to God!

Although Mass attendance has been on the rise, we have not seen a corresponding increase in our receipts (i.e. collections). This is putting a significant strain on our Parish finances and is causing us to run

in a DEFICIT POSITION for the first 3 months of the year.

I would ask that you prayerfully consider whether you may be in a position to increase your contribution to help us cover our costs.

There is so much to be thankful for here at St. Patrick's! The Holy Spirit is very active here and continues to inflame our hearts with His love. May God continue to bless us and pour down His abundant graces upon us!
