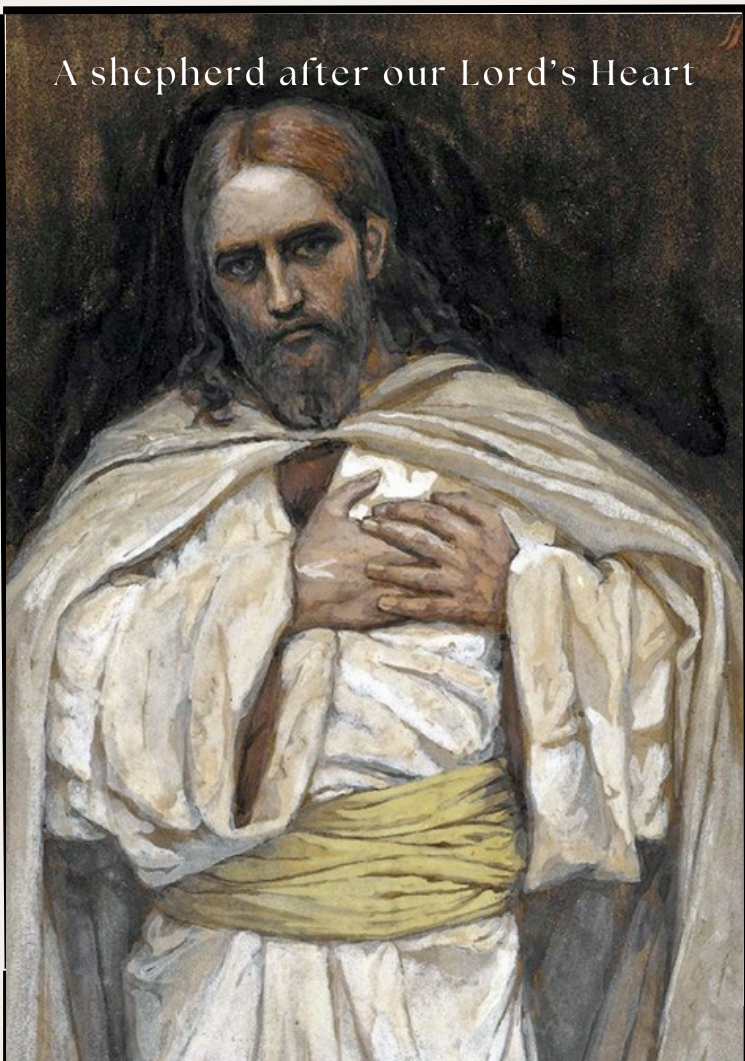

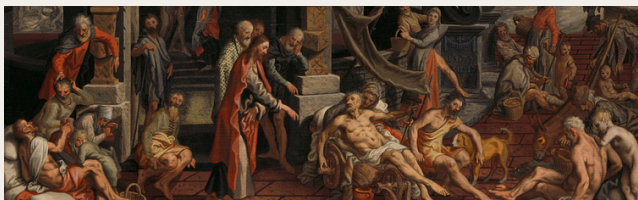
St. Patrick's Senior's group is inviting new members to join them for playing card games (Bridge, Cribbage, Canasta) and fellowship.

“What is going on? There seems to be a hurried pace by which my family is basically dragging me to go somewhere... I think we have arrived... Who is this man? 


If you are interested in registering your student for Kindergarten, we require the student's birth certificate, catholic baptism of student or parent, and proof of current address.

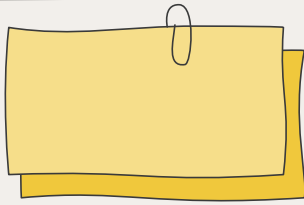
