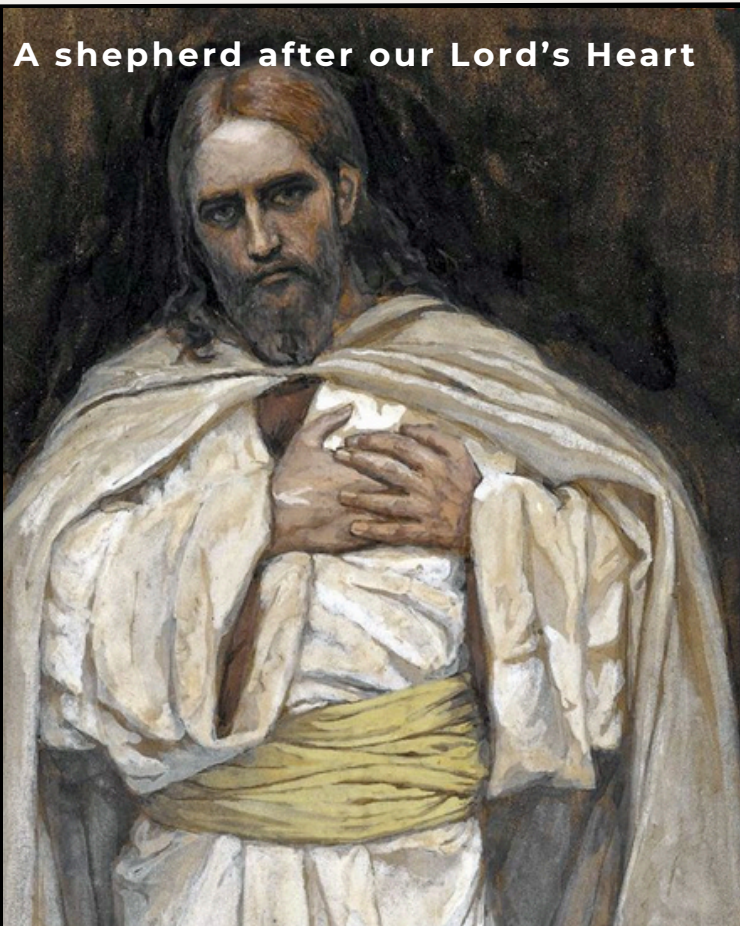

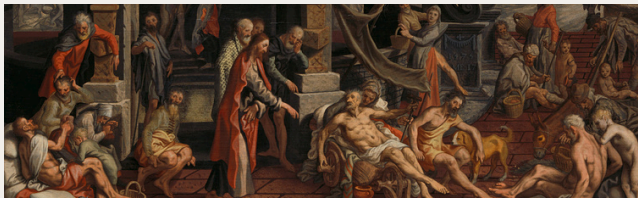

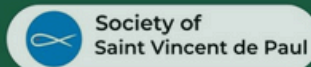


Relentless in His pursuit of man, God calls Abram, aged 75, to leave his home for Canaan with the promise that Abram will become a great nation, his name will be made great, and through him all families of the earth will be blessed. Several years pass with no child, Abram doubts the promise. God reassures him through the covenant of the cutting of the 3-year-old animals. More years pass, still childless, Sarai and Abram take matters into their own hands, resulting to a son, Ishmael, through Hagar. God intervenes in the mess to provide for Ishmael and Hagar and to establish the right heir. Finally, God reminds Abram, now 99, of the promise. Abram becomes Abraham, Sarai becomes Sarah, the promise becomes a covenant through the sign of circumcision.

Happily ever after? Not quite. The drama continues. We arrive at Mount Moriah. The Lord makes a big ask – “Abraham, will you offer up your only beloved son?” “Isaac, will you offer up yourself to be bound and sacrificed on the altar?”

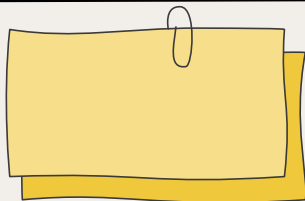
