To love or to be loved – which is more important?

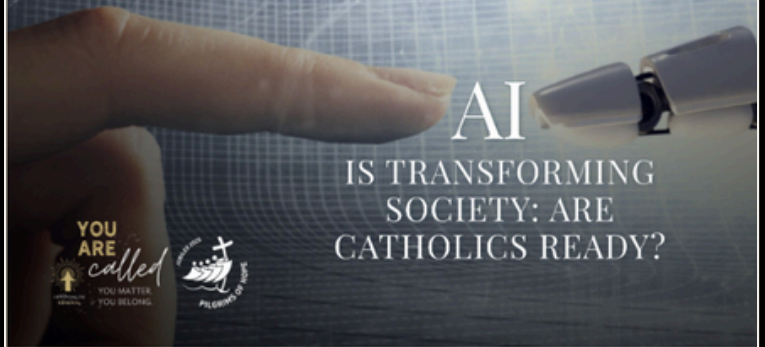
Wouldn't it be much nobler to love? Do we not pray, in the Litany of Humility, for Jesus to deliver us from the desire of being loved? Indeed our track record, however, shows that we miss the mark of true love. We are so inclined to selfishness that even when we intend kindness we either withhold or impose ourselves. This disorder has been our lot since Adam and Eve rejected God's offer of love, and this cannot be undone.

However, and much more important, when we were created in God's image and likeness we were gifted with the capacity for generosity, wisdom and love. Within us lies this paradox. Does it sound like a hopeless situation? Yes, if we navel gaze. But if we turn our gaze upon the Lover of our soul we will find that since the beginning of time God has been offering us a love like no other, an eternal, unconditional, sacrificial love of a loving Father. Not that imperfect father experience we may have, but that which, if we accept the Father's offer, will immerse us in a love so bright to then move us to offer that same kind of love to others. Only then can we genuinely love because our Father's love will empower us.

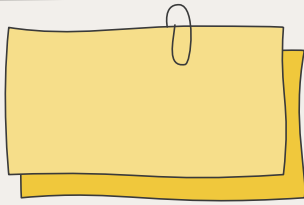
