Who Art in Heaven

St. Faustina's vision of heaven in entry 777 of her diary is bursting with the word happiness. **Heaven is happiness, our eternal home, a place that Jesus promised He is preparing while we pilgrims wait for Him to take us up, so that we may be where He is.**

Remember the son who renounced his sonship and pretended that his father was dead? He left his home for the seemingly dazzling distant country, hoping to find freedom and pleasure, and recklessly spent his inheritance until he ran out. He ran out. He began to be in want, like a branch that withered, having cut himself off the vine, bearing no fruit, good for burning. Emptied. The pigsty that brought the son to his senses – isn't that the consequence of sin? From the depth of his misery he realized his father's goodness. And the father? He has been waiting for his son to return home. In the here and now, that home is our heart, where, every time we pray and partake of the sacraments, our hearts are lifted to our Lord's heart, beyond cheek to cheek as the song goes, but heart speaking to heart. 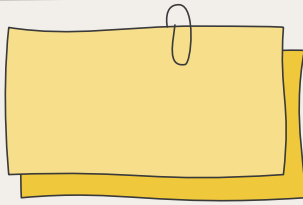
