
Thy Will be Done

It is the hardest thing, to do God's will. There is the ignorance of what doing God's will means. There is the question of how one could really know God's will. There is the assertion of free will that seems incompatible with bending ours to God's. There is the drowning in tragedies and hurts that makes one question whether such is God's will. There could be a life history of being abandoned, neglected, cheated, which leads to a drive for selfsufficiency. There is the belief in a prosperity gospel. At the opposite end are the saints who lived with abandon to every moment of their lives, equally embracing every suffering and persecution as they embraced moments of ecstatic consolation.

Is there a middle ground? Scripture says that people who are lukewarm, neither hot nor cold, will be spit out of the Lord's mouth. But Scripture also reveals to us that we are allowed to express our disappointment and anger over what we may perceive as injustice. We are invited to keep asking, to keep seeking, to keep knocking. Scripture says that Jesus also stands at the door and knocks, ready to help us do as He did, to do God's will. God wills our sanctification, that we be partakers in His divine nature, to be in a state of grace just like Adam and Eve were before the fall. This petition to our Father is to ask for a trustful surrender to everything that comes our way.

Where do we start to know and do God's will? For God so loved the world... Start believing that we are loved, that God wills our good, that everything works for our good when we love God.











