EPHPHATHA - Be Opened

Lead Us Not Into Temptation But Deliver Us From Evil

The forbidden fruit partaken by Adam and Eve was regarded as being good for food, a delight to the eyes, and desirable to make one wise. Solomon was forbidden to acquire great numbers of horses, wives, and silver and gold, all of which he had enormous amounts of toward the end of his life. Forewarned but unheeded.

Jesus was tempted in the 3 ways that St. John wrote are things of the world – lust of the flesh, lust of the eyes, and pride of life, corresponding to the temptations by which all humanity falls. Jesus overcame the tempter, and began his ministry of setting us, captives of the tempter, free. In the garden of Gethsemane, Jesus continued to surrender His will, sweating drops of blood in extreme anguish. Then before allowing Himself to be brutally scourged, Jesus warned His disciples to watch and pray so as not to fall into temptation.

There is no escaping the lures of the prince of the world as long as we live. Jesus reminds us that we are unforsaken children of our Father in Heaven, and calls us to resist the tempter by way of praying to combat pride of life, fasting to combat lust of the flesh, and almsgiving to combat lust of the eyes.

PONDER IN GOD'S PRESENCE:

In persons who are ...intensely purifying their sins and rising from good to better in the service of God our Lord,... the evil spirit will bite, sadden, and place obstacles, disquieting with false reasons, so that the person may not go forward...

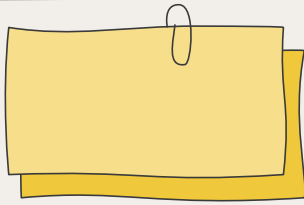

God's own Son, hanging on a tree with the inscription "King of the Jews" does not produce automatic faith/assent. Two groups are at the foot of the cross: those who recognize Jesus as King, and those who oppose and taunt him. We find both believers and opponents hanging next to and standing below the cross. This scene is a summary of Luke's entire Gospel: Jesus offers salvation and reaches out to those who ask, and who recognize their need for redemption. Thus, even though Jesus' kingship exists on a cosmic level, it is an established fact: in this life only our assent in faith reveals that kingship.
