EPHPHATHA - Be Opened



Poverty of the Sacred Host, Be All To Me.

Jesus opens His mouth on the mountain and offers a striking paradox: the promise of His kingdom paired with the call to poverty. It is so like Him to place littleness at the very doorway of greatness. Anyone who reads Scripture knows this is God's way - God overturns human expectations.

If we struggle to understand poverty of spirit, we need only look to the Eucharist.

In the Sacred Host, Jesus - the Son of God, the King of kings, the Lord of lords - is reduced to a humble circle of bread.

He becomes small enough for a child's palm, gentle enough for a sinner's hands, so vulnerable that He offers no defense against being mishandled, ignored, forgotten.

Why does He descend so far? Because He is not drawn to our accomplishments, our strength, our curated image. Instead, He whispers a quiet invitation to acknowledge truth:

I am not self-sufficient. I need God for everything. Everything I have is a gift. Everything I am is grace. I do not need to have it all together. I do not need to be impressive. I need to surrender.

This poverty may feel like loss, yet the paradox continues to unfold.

When I let go, He gives me treasure. When I lower myself, He lifts me. When I surrender, He leads me.

PONDER IN GOD'S PRESENCE:

The Bread of Angels becomes the Bread of men. Heaven stoops low to feed me, to fill me, to change me, to raise me. The One whom angels adore comes to me in poverty so that, in my poverty, I may receive the riches of His kingdom.

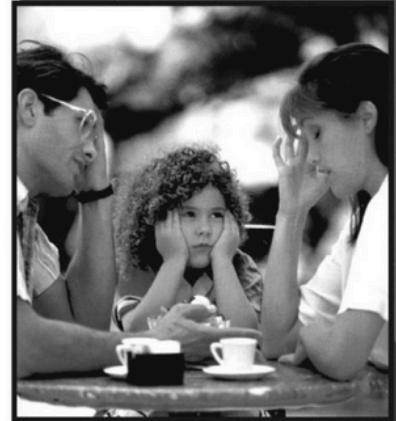

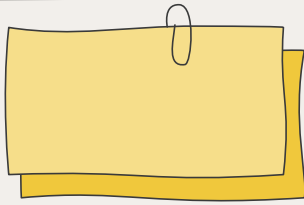

The Beatitudes are well-known among both Christians and non-Christians. They have become the signature of the Christian message, forming the substance of Jesus' teaching. To call the poor, the mourning, the hungry, the persecuted "blessed" seems at first reading ludicrous – another upside-down move on God's part. When we realize that Jesus makes these pronouncements from the perspective of God's glory in which he himself shares, we realize that the poor, the mourning, the hungry, the persecuted are all identified with the Son of God who died on the cross: poor, despised and falsely condemned. It is Jesus' capacity to hold divinity and humanity in loving tension in his moment of death, which makes us truly blessed in all our afflictions.
